General Information

Enga College of Nursing is an affiliated institution with Pacific Adventist University. The College runs a four year Bachelor Nursing program and accepts students from all parts of the country. Enga CoN is dedicated to provide quality education within a Christian context. Demonstrating competent, and safe nursing practice required of a nurse who works collaborate with other health professionals promoting team work. ECoN is committed to developing student nurses to be competent, dedicated, and caring Christian nurses applying knowledge and skills acquired to change the urban and rural health settings in PNG.

We also expects students to be responsible for their own learning and accountable behaviour.

We also trust that students will develop increasing maturity, in personal, interpersonal and spiritual aspects of their life and will contribute to the Christian ethics of the institution.

The institution is situated within the re-established Sopas hospital grounds and hosts more than 100 general nurse students. Each group of nurses have their own classrooms, which are used for lectures and private study.

It is a National Government institution with Enga Provincial Government as its primary state holder. Enga College of Nursing also fosters Seventh Day Adventist principles and student activities are based on a Christian way of life with spiritual enrichment thus expected to be willing to build up a Christian personality and community.

Enga College of Nursing welcomes qualified candidates from all over Papua New Guinea regardless of race, religion, and colour and gender status. ECoN accepts candidates depending on the evidence of good character, academic capability and a willingness to respect the faith, beliefs, mission and lifestyle of the Seventh Day Adventist.

The SDA Sabbath is observed from sunset Friday evening to sunset Saturday evening, which students are expected to respect the Sabbath hours and refrain from activities that would interfere with personal and organised worship programme during this period.

Entry Requirements

You must meet the following requirements to be considered in to the Nursing program.

- Completed grade 12 or matriculation upgrade.
- Minimum of GPA 3.0 and above
- Minimum of grade B in Language Literature, Advance Maths, Biology and Physic and grade C in Chemistry.
- Must have a mature and responsible attitude towards their future career and community
- Have not been convicted of any criminal offence
- Must have sober habits
- Must be medically fit without any major disabilities (mute, blindness, amputees, Congenital abnormallies,

Required Supporting documents

Submit the following documents with your application:

- One recent passport size ID Photo with *your name and signature* on the back of the photo (*scanned/electronic copy is fine*)
- Certified copy of your Grade 12 Higher School Certificate
- Certified copy of your Grade 10 High School Certificate
- Certified copy of your most recent academic transcript/s
- Certified copy of your NID card, or birth certificate, recent school ID card or staff ID card
- Two (2) References from a Church Pastor or ward councillor and School Principal to indicate candidate's honesty, commitment and reliability.
- Spouse consent letter (Only married applicants)
- Copy of deposit butt (K100.00 fee for application)
- Medical Examination report
- Police Clearance

Note: Ensure that all required documents are attached with the application to avoid any penalties.

Successful applications

Successful applicants will be officially advised via mobile phone or through email to sit for the **Admission Examination** at a specific date and place set by the Selection Committee. Candidates who passed the Admission Examination will be given an Offer for admission upon an Official Acceptance Letter from the Administration Office.

If you do not received any feedback from the ECoN Administration regarding your application, consider your application as not successful.

Late submission of application

- a) Applications submitted late after the closing date will not be considered by the ECoN Administration
- b) Incomplete applications will be disqualified¹

False documents or fraudulent documents

All the applications will be screened, certified and if there is any false in the documents or statement; the application will be disqualified or excluded.
